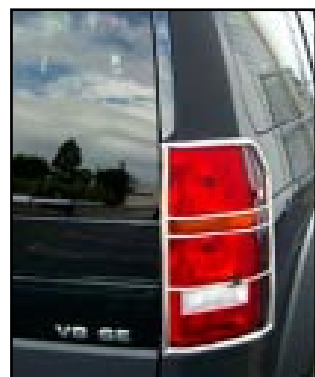


Wraparound Brush Bar:
Stainless 11021-2

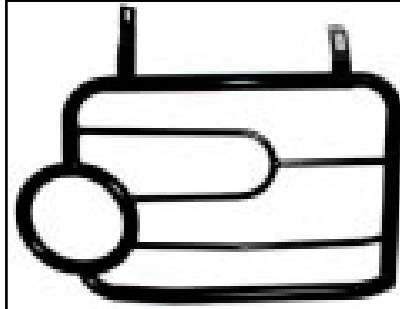
'A' Bar:

Traditional brush bars are great for light off roading. They protect the front of the truck from brush off road, and from errant shopping carts at the store. Plus they just look cool. Europe has banned metal brush guards (not 'pedestrian friendly') and all of the Land Rover Genuine accessories

are made of soft plastic. Not exactly the best thing for off road use, and they look clunky. These bars are made of metal and come in stainless or black. Mounting instructions are included, and no holes are required.



Metal Light Guards: Stainless or Black



Rear Lamp Guards, pair:

These light guards look very similar to Genuine, but are made of metal rather than plastic, and are about half the price! They fit in existing holes so there is no drilling required. Both front and rear are available in stainless or black. Mounting instructions included. (Check with local laws: some states do not permit light guards.)



Tubular Side Steps: Stainless or Black

Stainless Side Bars/Steps: 200112-2

Side bars combine the practicality of a 'running board' step with the off road practicality of a tubular protection bar. Tubular bars are less prone to snagging brush and can slide off rocks (although these are not full rock sliders they will provide protection in light duty use). The heavy tube walls make them great for dual use, and the rubber step insert helps prevent your foot from slippage. In bad weather conventional running boards can accumulate snow or mud, which are less of a problem with tube style bars.
