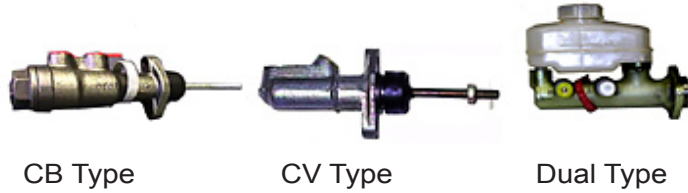

Note: Never use an 88 master cylinder with a 109 brake system. While they may look the same, the 109 master cylinder pumps a larger volume of fluid to work two front wheel cylinders at each front wheel.

Note: On 88 dual brake systems the front master cylinder outlet powers the front brakes and the rear outlet powers the rear brakes. On 109 dual brake systems the front master cylinder outlet powers the rear brakes and the rear outlet powers the front brakes.

Fluid Reservoir



The original style fluid reservoir is no longer available. Our replacement reservoir looks like the original except that both outlets are at the bottom.
