

Tread Lightly when on the trail

Concerns about damage to the environment has lead to closings of public lands. Each of us needs to set an example to others that public lands can be enjoyed by four wheel drivers and not damaged.

It is important that we stay on established trails. Desert ecosystems are very fragile and the damage done by one vehicle making its own trail can take close to 100 years to reverse. In less arid ecosystems driving off established trails can create new erosion paths that can add additional silt into waterways.

Practice low impact camping and try to leave no trace of your camp site when you leave. Carry all your trash out. Do not partially burn it and leave it or even attempt to bury it.

There are always a few Yahoos who by their actions ruin everything for us all. It never hurts to do camp site and trail trash cleanup as you travel. Leaving a campsite and trail cleaner than when you found it can only help us all.

Aluminum Bridge Ladders



Bridge Ladders are designed to get you across those deep narrow washes, crevasses between rocks, or partial washouts on dirt roads. They are much stronger than sand ladders or PSP. You can also lean them against embankments to get that front bumper up over the step.

And yes, you can just lay them flat in front of your wheels and use them as traditional sand ladders.

Our aluminum Bridge Ladders are beautifully made and sold as a pair. They are 5' long and accommodate a 10" tire tread width. Weight is only 20 lbs. each, much less than steel planks. They will accommodate a fully loaded 109 station wagon with no problem.

Aluminum Sand Ladder

Wide, strong aluminum sand ladders for getting out of the soft stuff. Heading out to the desert or beach this summer? Going where there's soft snow? Better have a set of these babies!

5 feet long and 17 3/4" wide, they will take the big tires. At only 16.5 lbs. each, they weigh a lot less than old steel psp planks.

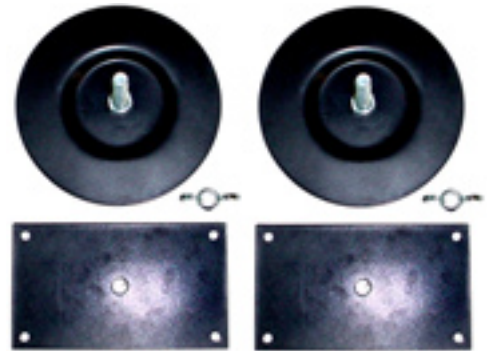
Sand Ladders are meant to be placed on the ground to spread the weight of your vehicle over the entire area of the sand ladders. They are not designed to be used for bridging gaps.
